


## Heart Sounds AORTIC PULMONIC (2nd Intercostal Space (2nd Intercostal Space R Sternal Border) L Sternal Border) TRICUSPID (3rd or 4th Intercostal Space L Sternal Border) **ERB'S POINT** MITRAL (3rd Intercostal Space (5th Intercostal Space L Sternal Border) Midclavicular Line)

## **APE To Man**

Aortic, Pulmonic, Erbs Point, Tricuspid, Mitral

These locations are optimal for listening to the 4 valves of the heart. Erb's point is the best location listen for S2. At each location you should listen for any murmur for the associated valve.



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
