

NEWBORN ASSESSMENT - CONDENSED

Appearance: pink, loud cry, well-flexed, full ROM

Fontanelles: anterior (diamond-shaped), posterior (triangular)

Mouth: Assess for cleft lip or palate

Heart: Assess for murmurs

Respirations: Assess breathing

Umbilical Cord: 1 Vein, 2 Arteries, Clamped

Extremities: Equal length, 10 fingers and toes

Genitalia:
Male: testes palpable
Female: discharge of blood or mucus normal

NEWBORN MEDS AND LABS

Vitamin K

prevent hemorrhage

Optic Antibiotic

prevent newborn blindness

PKU Level

within 24 hrs after feeding begins

Coombs' Test

if mother Rh-neg.

Immunizations

Hep-B can be given
