First Degree

Reddened,
painful, intact
skin



Second Degree

Partial
Thickness,
broken skin,
pain, pink/red,
blisters



Third Degree

Full thickness,
often painless,
white/black
eschar



Fourth Degree

Muscle and/or
bone exposed.
Common in
electrical
burns
