# **HOW TO REVIEW YOUR NPQ™ RESULTS**

# 🗄 NPQ

When you answer a question in NPQ<sup>™</sup>, you will see the correct answer and a detailed rationale. But where do you go from there? This guide will help!

## When taking individual questions in NPQ™

Have a piece of paper out so you can take notes about your results

#### If you got the question <u>right</u>:

- Read the rationale to solidify your knowledge (make sure you got it right for the right reasons!)
- Then MOVE ON! Don't spend much time onthe ones you got right!

#### If you got the question wrong:

- Before you look at the rationale, review the correct answer
  - Do you see what you did wrong?
  - Did you misread or misinterpret the question?
  - Did you miss a keyword?
  - Did you just not understand the topic?
  - Did you fall into a test-taking trap?
- Now review the rationale
  - Make sure you understand why the right answer is right and why the wrong answers are wrong
  - Provide feedback on the question if you have any issues
  - Make note of the error you made or the misunderstanding you had
- Make note of the Nursing Category
- Make note of the topic and what body system is involved
- Repeat with each question you take in NPQ<sup>™</sup> or inside of specific Lessons

#### Review your overall results after taking at least 100 NPQ™

- Do you see any patterns?
  - Did you read into a lot of the questions?
  - Did you fall into the same test-taking trap repeatedly?
  - Are you missing key words in the questions?
- What Nursing Categories are you struggling with?
  - Is there a body system you're consistently missing?
  - Do you struggle with prioritization?
  - Do you struggle with management of care?



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#### Use those identified areas of weakness

- Focus on those specific lessons related to the questions you missed
- Take 25-50 NPQ<sup>™</sup> in each of your 3-4 lowest Nursing Category and to improve your results in those categories

### When you finish a SIMCLEX™ attempt:

- Review your overall results for patterns
- Make note of your 3-4 weakest areas
- Review ONLY the questions you got wrong using the above strategies
- Use your identified areas of weakness to review content and take more NPQ<sup>™</sup> based on those lowest categories
- GOAL:
  - Passing SIMCLEX™
  - $\circ\,$  50-60% accuracy in all categories
