ADVANCED DIRECTIVES

Ask all patients if they have an Advanced Directive. If so, be sure to get a copy for their medical record!

Living Will

- Legal Document
- Written out for instances for which a patient cannot communicate their decisions
- Includes Code Status
 - ° Full Code
 - DNR Do Not Resuscitate
 - Partial DNR
- Needed prior to injury, illness, hospitalization and/or treatment

Medical Power of Attorney

- Legal Document
- Different than Durable Power of Attorney (DPOA)
- Designates a particular person or persons to make medical decisions for the patient
- In the absence of a MPOA, state laws dictate who makes medical decisions
- Needed by those who may, at some point, be unable to voice their own decisions regarding medical care.

Hospital social workers or chaplains can help patients complete Advanced Directives while they are hospitalized.
