

# WOUND DRAINS

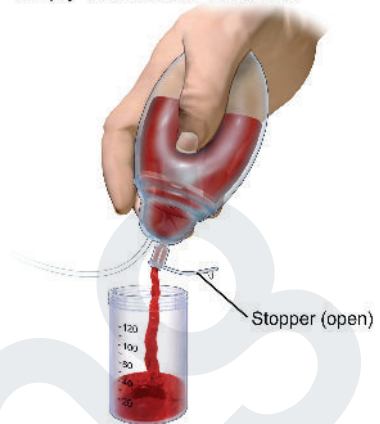
## Penrose Drain



- Open drainage system
- Held in place by a sterile safety pin
- Could be covered with gauze or contained within a wound pouch

## Jackson-Pratt Bulb

Empty the Jackson Pratt Bulb

- Long tube with fenestrations (holes) inside the wound
- Connected to bulb
- Bulb is squeezed to create suction

## Hemovac

- Tube with holes inside the wound
- Accordion press to create suction

## Wound Vac



- Foam dressing in wound
- Covered with transparent film
- Hole cut in film to attach vacuum suction
- Vacuum machine attached and turned on to physically pull drainage out
- Improves granulation and wound healing
