Pre-Administration Assessment:	Post Administration Evaluation:	Nursing Considerations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contraindicated with penicillin allergy</li><li>• May cause seizures</li><li>• Assess for rash, anaphylaxis</li><li>• Excreted by kidneys – monitor renal labs</li><li>• Monitor patient for diarrhea – bloody stool should be reported immediately</li></ul>
