Pre-Administration Assessment:	Post Administration Evaluation:	Nursing Considerations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Contraindicated in cephalosporin and possibly penicillin allergies• May need lead to seizures, pseudomembranous colitis, diarrhea, phlebitis at IV site, anaphylaxis• Assess infection and allergies• Obtain cultures prior to therapy• Monitor bowel function• May lead to superinfection
