Pre-Administration Assessment:	Post Administration Evaluation:	Nursing Considerations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Can cause jaundice</li><li>• May cause peripheral neuropathy, seizures, hepatitis</li><li>• Patient should avoid high amounts of tyramine (pickled meats, aged/smoked meats, alcohol, exotic/aged cheese)</li><li>• Monitor liver function tests</li><li>• Complete full course of therapy (6-12 months)</li><li>• Often used in combination with Rifampin</li></ul>
