Pharmacologic Class: • Pyrrozone carboxylic acid

Therapeutic Class: • Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory agents
• Nonopioid analgesics

Action: Pain relief due to prostaglandin inhibition by blocking of the enzyme cyclooxygenase (COX)

Pre-Administration Assessment:	Post Administration Evaluation:	Nursing Considerations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• may cause GI bleeding, Stevens-Johnson Syndrome, anaphylaxis, drowsiness• should not exceed 5 days of therapy• bleeding risk increased with garlic, ginger, and ginkgo• May decrease effectiveness of hypertensive medications and diuretics
