## Warfarin Coumadin **Trade Name Generic Name** Pharmacologic Class: • Coumarins Therapeutic Class: • Anticoagulant Action: Disrupts liver synthesis of Vitamin K dependent **Indication:** • Venous thrombosis Pulmonary embolism clotting factors A-fib • Myocardial infarction Reason Given (Disease States): \_\_\_\_\_ **Nursing Process** Pre-Administration Assessment: | Post Administration Evaluation: **Nursing Considerations:** • Contraindicated with bleeding, severe hypertension Can cause bleeding • Aspirin and NSAIDs can increase risk of bleeding • Azole antifungals increase effects of warfarin • Cimetadine(Tagamet) increases warfarin levels • Obtain full history of supplements and herbs • Large amounts of vitamin K may antagonize effects of warfarin • Assess for signs of bleeding • Therapeutic levels: PT 1.3-1.5, INR 2.5-3.5 • Instruct patient to report any signs of bleeding • Patient should not drink alcohol • Bleeding times need to be monitored frequently • Vitamin K is antidote Other:\_\_\_\_
