## Local Anesthetic Systemic Toxicity (LAST) Nursing Interventions

## LAST is easily prevented:

- 1. Know your max dose for the patient
  - a. Documentation is key
- 2. Old and Young Vulnerable (kidney disease)
- **3. Symptoms:** (may mimic PACU patients)
  - a. Mouth numbness/metallic taste
  - b. Confusion
  - c. Seizures
  - d. Hallucinations
  - e. Dysrhythmia
  - f. Low blood pressure
- 4. Bier block
  - a. Double tourniquet applied
- 5. Lipid Emulsion
  - a. 20% IV solution
  - b. Moves anesthetic away from organs to muscles/liver
- 6. Monitoring
- 7. Communication is critical!!!
  - a. Amount given (include anesthesia), time out as needed
