Acute Coronary Syndrome (ACS)

ACS is- the suspicion or confirmed presence of acute myocardial ischemia (caused by poor perfusion)

| Perfusion = Delivery of Oxygenated Blood |

Poor perfusion cases:

• Clots, narrowed arteries, or vasospasms

The 3 Categories of Acute Coronary Syndrome:

- Unstable angina partial occlusion (tiny kink)
- NSTEMI more occlusion medium sized kink
- STEMI Complete occlusion (artery blocked)=
 Emergency

Heart Muscle Pumps:

Hose=artery (gets kinked/clogged) → Tissues= garden (poor perfusion)
